### **A. EXPLANATORY NOTE - ARRIVAL CARD:**

All international airports required visitors to complete an Arrival Card to be produced to the Immigration Officer upon arrival. Air stewards usually supply such card before disembarkation

Before the visitors depart the country, most countries require the Departure Card to be completed and produced to the Immigration authorities. Some countries will retain the duplicate copy of Arrival Card for departure purposes otherwise a fresh Card need to be completed and produced as shown below:-
